CRANBERRY PUDDING**



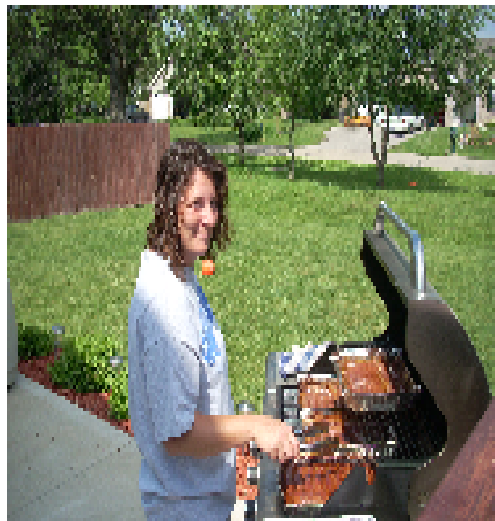
- 2 Eggs, beaten
- 2 Tbsp. Sugar
- Pinch of Salt
- 1/2 C. Molasses
- 2 tsp. Baking Soda
- 1/3 C. Boiling Water
- 1 1/2 C. Sifted Flour
- 1 1/2 C. Cranberries, cut in half

Combine eggs, sugar, salt and molasses. In a separate container, put 2 tsp. of soda in 1/3 c. boiling water. Add to egg mixture. Stir in flour and cranberries. Steam in a buttered rice steamer for 1 1/2 hours. Serve warm with following sauce.

SAUCE:

- 2 Sticks Butter 2 Cups Sugar 1 Cup Half & Half

Melt butter. Add sugar and half & half and stir until sugar is dissolved. ENJOY!!!
