2/3 C. Oleo

8 oz. Cool Whip

1 can Cherry Pie Filling

Mix cream cheese, sugar & vanilla, beating until smooth. Add marshmallows & cool whip. Spread over graham cracker crust and then spread cherry pie filling over cream cheese mixture. Refrigerate 3 hours before serving.
